I Will, report to the proper authorities any individuals who enter and or remove artifacts from Federal Parks or State Preserves.

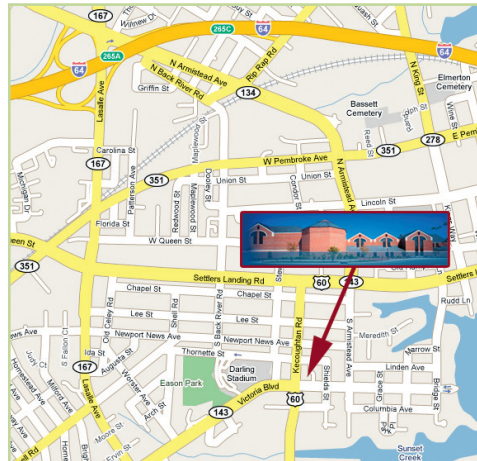

Our goal is to educate our current members as well as future members in the hobby of metal detecting. With our community's rich history, it is sometimes difficult to find locations that are legal to hunt in Virginia. During our meetings we review any recent changes in legislature towards metal detecting and relic hunting as well display our recently found treasures with one another.

Two Official Treasure Hunts Each Year (Spring and Fall)

HRRS Treasure Hunts happen twice a year and are usually beach hunts requiring minimal equipment (metal detector, sand scoop and a bag or basket for found items). A marked area is seeded with various coins and tokens for the participants to locate using a metal detector. Any tokens found are then turned in for prizes at the end of the day. These organized hunts are a lot of fun for both participants and observers alike and help to promote the hobby.

While we strive to have these hunts as open to the public as possible, due to local ordinance issues and city restrictions we have had to limit them to members only style hunts for now. They are open to club members only and allow our members to meet as a group on the field and teach each other different techniques for finding those illusive treasures. This is a great time to see each of our members in action with their favorite gear and is an educational experience for those new to metal detecting to learn how to use their metal detecting equipment effectively to get the most enjoyment from it.

A minimal hunt fee and club membership is all that is required to participate. Check out our website for the schedule for our next competition hunt.

Group Sessions

On the second Saturday of each month we get together for group sessions. These are monthly informal times to get together and hunt as a club at a variety of locations in the Hampton Roads area. Those needing assistance with their detector settings can get help or if you just want to chat with a great group of people come check us out.
